### **Becoming a Local Ministry Outreach Director**

Thank you for your interest in starting and leading a new outreach through New Life Church Local Ministries. Local directors, leaders and teams are vital to fulfilling our local mission to love our people and our greater New Life vision to worship, connect, and serve. Our desire is that the ways we engage our city with love are a reflection of God's heart for his people, the true needs in the city, and the passions of our leaders and congregation. In order for us to equip you as a director for effective and sustainable outreach in our city, we ask that you submit your proposal, undergo an approval process, and meet all requirements of a local ministry director before beginning your outreach. This is to ensure that you are not only prepared for the leadership experience ahead of you, but also that you are supported and encouraged along the way.

Please read through the entire outline and become familiar with all steps, requirements, and responsibilities of Local Ministry leadership before embarking on this approval process. Please also be aware that although this outline summarizes the start-up process, the approval for new ministries is always prayer-driven and Spirit-led and therefore subject to the discretion of pastoral leadership.

# **First Things First**

#### Pray.

Every single outreach is guided and initiated by prayer and we will always begin an outreach by praying. This is to ensure the outreach is not only a good idea, but is guided by the Father and intentional.

#### **Prayerfully consider:**

- ✓ Is God leading me towards starting a new local outreach?
- ✓ What has God been speaking to me about this idea through His Word?
- ✓ Who will be my support system I can lean on and trust?
- ✓ Am I willing and able to be committed to this ministry long term?
- ✓ Do I have the capacity in my life to do this with excellence?
- ✓ Do others around me affirm this as a good idea for me right now?



#### What am I signing up for?

We want you to know exactly what to expect in the months to come. So you aren't caught off guard, here is what we expect from you as a director:

- ✓ Consistently pray for Local leadership and teams, for the people of our city, and to ask God how you can continue to love your people.
- ✓ Complete a Dream Team Application.
- ✓ Maintain a posture of humility and a teachable heart in serving.
- ✓ Maintain focus in outreach.
- ✓ Be willing to adapt and change.
- ✓ Be transparent and honest with Local staff and team.
- ✓ Serve in capacities that correlate to your identity.
- ✓ Read and uphold the local values.
- ✓ Complete CERVIS volunteer management training.
- ✓ Participate in the prayer, planning, implementation, and follow up of your outreach, which may include interviewing and training volunteers.
- ✓ Be ready and willing to serve no more and no less than the agreed amount per month.
- ✓ Consider and equip leaders to lead with you and after you.
- ✓ Lead teams of volunteers.
- $\checkmark$  Attend 4 of 6 leadership meetings per year.



## How will I be assisted by Local?

You don't have to have all the skills or know how to be a director. While basic qualifications are necessary, a heart and passion for others, a willingness to serve, and a genuine relationship with Christ set the groundwork for a successful director and team. We recognize you may need training, support, resources and guidance as the outreach gets going. We are committed to supporting you in the following ways:

#### **New Life Church Support**

Each outreach looks different and requires different things. Local is committed to supporting you with appropriate and necessary resources New Life Church offers through local ministries. This includes but is not limited to printing, design, volunteer management, meeting space, web exposure, platforms for communication, financial resources, department partnerships, and pastoral oversight.

#### **Local Leadership Meetings**

A time for team directors and leaders to be inspired, encouraged, and equipped. Prayer, storytelling, and training will always be a part of these meetings. Leadership Meetings occur every other month. <u>Team Directors must attend 4 of 6 per year.</u>

#### **Ongoing Training and Teaching**

Training will be given according to specific needs of director and outreach. Training may include one on one, national trainings, leadership equipping workshops, pastoral counseling, etc.

#### One on One Meetings with Leadership

Pastoral oversights and consistent support is available and encouraged for directors.


#### **Yearly Retreat**
